Sunday School

- Gospel Light is the curriculum, which is recycled every two years. "Dare to be a Daniel" by Franklin Graham was the curriculum used for the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls this past fall.
- Promotion Sunday occurs in the fall.

Children's Church

- Revision to the "Bible Story Boxes" from the previous year. Currently each child receives a Children's Illustrated Bible. We started from the beginning of the Bible, and we are working our way through the Bible. Each week the child takes home a memory verse that goes with the story for that week.
- Rick Bauer does the Bible story; Jessica and Julie Bauer coordinate the activities; and Thad Bauer & Brittany Beck serve as helpers.
- It meets during third service with an average of thirty children, ages four through second grade.

Children's After School Bible Study

- Meets on Tuesdays from 3:30 PM – 5:00 PM for grades K-6.
- The curriculum was entitled "Jesus the One and Only" & "Beloved Disciple" by Beth Moore which we finished in October.
- Starting in January 2010 our curriculum will be entitled "Bible Skills, Drills, & Thrills" by LifeWay.
