

MEXICO MISSION TRIPS – 2009 REPORT

FEBRUARY MISSION TRIP to Juarez, Mexico:

Most of our group flew out of Rapid City on Wednesday, February 4 and returned on Monday, February 9. The group passed out hundreds of Spanish New Testaments and engaged in public evangelism in Juarez colonials.

Projects included construction on a home, roof repair, and dental services. A real highlight of the week was helping at an Operation Christmas Child rally where the group handed out the shoebox presents to the kids and a gospel presentation was given.

SUMMER MISSION TRIP to Juarez, Mexico:

The summer group underwent extensive evangelism training. Each missionary was required to complete a daily Bible study as well as training in doctrine, evangelism, and apologetics. This was a brave group that overcame fears of H1N1 and the violence that Juarez is known for.

Evangelism was the emphasis of the group with approximately 14,000 people who were provided the true gospel from Pierre to Juarez. In Juarez the group passed out close to 5,000 Spanish New Testaments. They also engaged in construction, house repair, roofing, painting, as well as working with the kids who attend the mission's after school program.

Please pray for our groups and the people of Mexico that the Lord might continue to have us participate in this spiritual harvest!

As of this time, Lord willing, our 2010 June trip is scheduled for June 11 – 21st.
