The list below highlights some of the activities held in 2009 by Women's Ministry at Community Bible Church:

- WM Annual Board meeting was held January 5, 2009. Various teams were formed and information was provided to the team leaders & members. The treasurer's report was given, showing a balance of \$1067.97, plus funding set aside for Native American Ministries (\$322.78) and \$353.15 for the Women's retreat. The 2010 annual meeting was set for January.
- Women's Bible studies are organized throughout the year, which reaches out to women not only in CBC, but also welcome women from around this in region of the state to study God's Word.
- A Valentine's Day Banquet was held focusing on strengthening marriages.
- A Father/Daughter Date night was held in March. The fathers and their daughters were treated to a pancake supper and lots of fun!
- Mother's Day Tea was held on Saturday, May 9, 2009, and over 100 people attended.
- College care packages were sent to students
- There were approximately 340 shoe boxes collected & sent for the Operation Christmas Child project
- The Women's Christmas Dinner is was held on December 7, 2009
- A website with information about CBC's Women's Ministry was established, with special support from Amy Kropp. Details of the ministry as well as photos and information of activities are included.
- A "welcome center" is being developed
- A prayer chain invitation is also included as one of the opportunities to serve through Women's Ministry.
- 2010 WM Annual Board meeting is planned for January 2010.

- The Nursery team is still in need of nursery workers; an insert in the bulletin and phone calls have been made to find volunteers, but there is still a need in this area.
- The food team coordinated support for those with illness, new babies, and various events in the church.
- As of December 31, 2009, the Women's ministry checkbook balance is \$1965.94 with the following amounts set aside, \$353.15 for Women's Retreat and \$185.00 for Bob Mill's Native American Ministry. This leaves a useable balance of \$1427.79.
