The Women's Ministry constitution was amended by the ladies of CBC to give pastors' wives the option of being ex-officio members of the Women's Ministry board.

Several Bible studies were held through-out the year. The Women's retreat for the year was a trip to a Women of Faith conference in St. Paul. These events reach out to CBC women and also to women in the community.

Event teams planned many special events for the year such as the Valentines banquet, Mother's Day tea, Women's Christmas dinner and Father/Daughter date night. Outreach events included Operation Christmas Child and college care packages.

Core teams lead by many amazing ladies from CBC provided comfort and support to many people via Food, Funeral, Kitchen and Nursery teams

Team sign-ups in the fall of 2011 provided volunteers to support most teams and events, more women are still needed for the Nursery and Kitchen teams.

The Women's Ministry has \$2525.36 on hand to fund events and outreach for 2012. There is \$265.23 designated for a women's retreat and \$185.00 for Bob Mill's ministry.
