New Sunday School Classes Starting Today



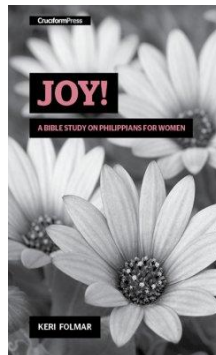

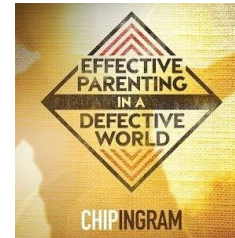
help us understand the book, and discuss the many great themes that arise. Join us as we journey along the path to the Celestial City!
