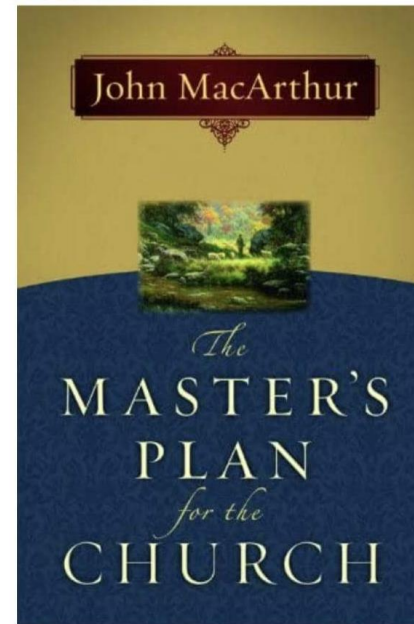
### **People of Promise: Kingdom Divided**
