Governor Grocery

What is Governor Grocery?

Governor Grocery is a student pantry program hosted at Georgia Morse Middle School. Students will be able to pick out (2) breakfasts (2) lunches, (2) suppers, and extra drinks and snacks for the weekend.



This program was created to help students who have food shortages at home. Students will be able to come down on Friday afternoons during their study hall or extra time and pick out their own items to take home for the weekend.

How can I help?

If you would like to donate items, you can drop them off in the main office at GMMS between the hours of 7:30am and 3:45pm Monday through Friday. What about High School students?

New this year is a breakfast meal for T.F. Riggs high school students that is available every morning Monday through Friday and is held at Capitol City Campus located at 925 E.
