## “MEMBER SPOTLIGHT”

### We Need Patience

I’ve not been a patient person for much of my life. Recently, our home air conditioning went out, and we have no expected fix date. With triple-digit temperatures recently, this situation has been particularly challenging. This isn’t a “poor me” moment; rather, this is a moment for me to express my need for God. In situations like these, it is easy to become frustrated and anxious, but we find support and strength in the Word of God.

The Bible teaches us the virtue of patience through numerous passages. James 1:3-4 reminds us, “The testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.” This verse is a source of encouragement for me, emphasizing that patience is not merely waiting but a process of growth and strengthening of our faith.
