“MEMBER SPOTLIGHT”

Participation Trophy

Have you ever been to a kid’s soccer game and wondered why they don’t keep score? What do you mean, “*Everyone* gets a trophy for participating?” One thing for sure, the kids (and parents) certainly know the score! Participation trophies have been a part of kids’ sports for generations, and opinions about them vary. No one can deny, though, that participating on a team builds character. Character development isn’t just about winning—it’s about growth, integrity, and learning from shared experiences.

Now let’s apply this to our Christian journey. A few weeks ago, I wrote about G.P.S., which is our blueprint for ministry, our roadmap for discipleship. The “G” stands for the GOSPEL. We can’t be Christ’s disciples if we don’t know Him personally. Step two is “P” which is PARTICIPATE. Philippians 1:3-5 says, “I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making my prayer with joy, because of your *partnership* in the gospel from the first day until now.” The word “Partnership” is *koinonia* in Greek. This word means “participation, fellowship, sharing, communion.”

When we trust in the Gospel we have joined team CHRIST, aka the Church. Our playbook is the Bible, our team practices include worship, Bible study, and building each other up. Our goal is to know Christ and make Him known. Our uniform is the righteousness of Christ. The analogies are endless. My point is that the next step after trusting Christ is actively participating in the body of Christ. While some go and sit in the bleachers, it’s critical to remember that the Christian life is not a spectator sport. And yes, there is a trophy for participating, because all who are in Christ have already won. More to come.
