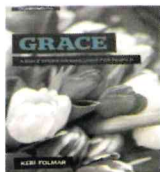

**Women's Class**

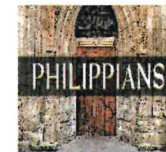

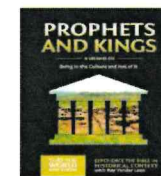
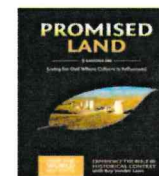
