Acceptable Sin

A couple of weeks ago, during our leadership class on Sunday afternoon, the focus was on sexual purity. We discussed an article that shed light on American attitudes regarding pornography. The author stated, “Almost half of those surveyed (48%) self-identified as Christian, which means that a significant number who claim to follow Christ not only use pornography but think it is beneficial. Could this be a sign that pornography is becoming an ‘acceptable sin’?” I sure hope that’s not the case!

The sixth commandment clearly states: “You shall not commit adultery” (Ex 20:14). Jesus interpreted this command for us and said, “You have heard that it was said, ‘You shall not commit adultery.’ But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman with lustful intent has already committed adultery with her in his heart” (Matt 5:27–28). When we apply Jesus’ instruction to our context, consuming pornography is committing adultery, and so Christians can never deem this wickedness as “acceptable.”

If you have doubts about what you are watching is sinful or not, seek guidance from the Holy Spirit. Also, when tempted, remember 1 Cor 10:13, where Paul explains, “No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.” We must replace the thoughts that lead us away from Christ with holy thoughts that lead us to Christ, mentally envisioning Christ sitting next to you. He is faithful. Pray for His assistance in finding a way out.
